Social Studies:

- 1 **YELLOW** college-ruled spiral notebook
- 1 2-pocket plastic folder with prongs

Math:

- 1 ruler (centimeters & inches)
- 1 pack 8 1/2 x 11" graph paper (4 squares per inch)
- 1 scientific calculator (Casio fx-260 preferred)
- One - 2" **BLACK** three-ring BINDER with 2 dividers and pockets
- 1 pack 4"x6" index cards (regular Math only)
- Colored Pens (or gel pens) for taking notes (optional)
- **For Accelerated Math 6:** 10 heavy duty sheet protectors
- 1 three subject – three-hole spiral notebook, (will use throughout middle school – this is accelerated Math only)

Science:

- 1 college-ruled 3-subject spiral notebook (any color)
- 1 ream white COPY paper

Spanish:

- 1 **RED** college-ruled spiral notebook
- 1 plastic folder with prongs

Fine Arts:

- 1 set of watercolor paints – at least 12 or more colors including white and black
- Colored pencils with a SOFT core, preferably NOT Crayola, with over 20 colors – see Amazon for deals. (Prismacolor is a good brand, but you are not limited to this option), make sure to include black, white and gray colors
- 1 white posterboard 22"x28"

Color-coding helps with organization, but the school understands that sometimes it is difficult to find certain colors. If you can't find designated colors, do the best you can.

Technology:

- Laptop (**NOT** iPad or tablet) to be used in class daily. Laptop must have the following programs loaded: Web Browser (i.e., Safari, Internet Explorer or Google Chrome), and a Slide Presentation (i.e. Keynote or PowerPoint). Other applications may be required by the class teacher, including programs that are available for free and some that may cost a nominal amount
- **REQUIRED:** Students must bring a charger to school every day.

Personal:

- 1 Pack of College-ruled paper

- Highlighters (yellow/pink/orange)

Homeroom: (For use in all middle school classrooms)

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STUDENT EARTHQUAKE COMFORT KIT

As part of the school's Emergency Preparedness Plan, each student is required to have a comfort kit to be stored in the school's emergency kit for the entire school year. This comfort kit must be sent with your child to school

NO LATER THAN Friday, August 21.

PRINT Student's Name, Grade and 2026 – 2027 on a gallon-sized (cannot be bigger) Ziploc bag with a permanent marker.

The following items are suggested, but personalize your child's comfort kit according to his/her needs:

- Photos of family, pets and activities
- Note from parents expressing love and hope
- A favorite small toy or tiny stuffed animal (Small Beany Baby size)

- Paper or small coloring pages, or activity/puzzle booklets, or playing cards
- Colored pencils and sharpener
- Clean underwear and socks
- Small travel size toothbrush, toothpaste, hair brush or comb
- If necessary, extra eye glasses (for those with prescriptions)
- Sunglasses
- Small cap or visor
- Barrettes, scrunchies, or other hair tie-backs for girls
- Favorite granola bar, hard candy, or gum (nothing that will melt)

Bags must be able to be zipped close. Please **do not over stuff** them. All comfort kits will be returned to parents at the end of the school year.
